A pair of unusual and good quality, three-light sterling silver candelabra in the Art Deco style with round bases supporting fluted stems with similarly fluted flat arms. These are good quality silver candlesticks are made in cast sections and are not filled.

Representing modernism, and one of the most exciting styles of the 20th century, Art Deco design originated in the 1920s and developed into a major style in Europe and the United States during the 1930s. Individually crafted luxury items were created with the intention of creating a sleek and anti-traditional elegance that symbolised wealth and sophistication. As a style, Art Deco works are symmetrical, geometric, streamlined, often simple, and pleasing to the eye. Its easy adaptability suits any interior and still influences design today.
