Set hand-forged Princes antique silver cutlery for 24

Description

Hand-forged Victorian silver cutlery set in the Prince's pattern for 24 people, all fitted in its original wooden canteen. Prince's pattern was first produced around 1860 and its simple scroll and leaf border is typical of the mid-Victorian style.

This silver cutlery service was made by Francis Higgins II of London, 1876-1878 unless otherwise indicated

24 table forks
24 dessert forks
24 dessert spoons
24 table spoons (12 by George Adams, 1873)

1 soup ladle
2 gravy spoons
3 sauce ladles
4 salt ladles
4 salt cellars (Richards & Brown 1877 & 1878)

Since antique knives rarely survive, this fine silver cutlery set is completed with 24 pairs of modern matching silver table and dessert knives with stainless steel blades, making them dishwasher safe.
