Description

Antique Victorian silver basting spoon in the Old English Thread pattern, engraved on the handle with a monogram "AJA".

This Old English variant was first made in the 1760s but became popular in the mid 1780s. The reverse is threaded and it makes a lovely variation to the Old English pattern. Spoons can be made with nibs front or back. Its classic simplicity makes Old English Thread a consistently popular choice.

The Chawners dominated the production of flatware in the middle years of the 19th century, making them an interesting and important family.
