Description

Art Deco era silver cocktail shaker featuring a finely engine turned engraving finish over the body and cover to create an almost satin or suede-like knurled effect. This smart three-piece cocktail shaker has a pull-off top that reveals the strainer beneath. A perfect piece for shaking up a zesty daquiri.

Art Deco was the popular design style spreading across Europe in the 1920s and 1930s and characterised especially by sleek geometric or stylised forms. It represented luxury, glamour, exuberance, and faith in social and technological progress. For that reason silver cocktail and barware were popular categories of goods to reflect the style of the time.
