Description

Victorian hand-forged silver cutlery set for 12 settings in the Kings Husk pattern and featuring the classic husk heel on the back of the spoons and forks. A lesser known variant of the Kings pattern, based around the hourglass form, Kings Husk was first produced during the Regency period. The elegant shape allied to the detailed and fine husk separate it from the more frequently and sometimes mass-produced King's and Queen's patterns. All pieces of this set were made by William & Elizabeth Eaton

The set comprises:

- 12 table forks
- 12 dessert forks
- 12 tablespoons
- 12 dessert spoons
- 12 teaspoons (6 are by another maker)

Since antique knives rarely survive, this cutlery set is completed with 12 matching modern pairs of Kings Husk silver table and dessert knives with stainless steel blades, making them suitable for the dishwasher.
