## Description

Fine, silver photograph style in a quintessential Art Deco style with buttress-shaped sides with a striped effect pattern of plain and engine-turned surfaces. The frame is supported by its original wood back and easel.

Art Deco was a popular design style in the 1920s and 30s characterised especially by sleek geometric or stylised forms. It represented luxury, glamour, exuberance, and faith in social and technological progress. For that reason decorative silver and silverware for entertaining were popular categories of goods to reflect the style of the time.

The portrait aperture will hold a 185mm X 250mm (7½" x 10") photograph.
